The festival will again be located at Sacajawea Park with high visibility from Highway 93 and Polson Bay.

Show hours: Saturday, July 29, 10am to 6pm, and Sunday, July 30, 10am to 5pm

The number of food vendor spaces will be limited, both because of space available and to help assure a successful event for all participants involved. Please be specific in describing your menu, to assist our committee in offering a variety of food options without duplication.

Conditions for participation in the Flathead Lake Festival of Art as a food vendor:

1. A license with the State of Montana is required (please attach a copy with application).
2. Vendors are responsible for the clean up of their individual spaces during and after the show. Food vendors must follow Lake County Regulations for sanitation and must have their Lake County Permit available to the Festival Committee.
3. Limited electricity may be available, however, food vendors need to be prepared to provide their own power source.
4. Booths will be set up on time and will remain open the entire duration of the show.
5. The show is outdoors and lakeside. Be prepared for rain or wind; the show will be held regardless of the weather. Security will be provided Saturday night, however, each vendor participates at his or her own risk. The Sandpiper Art Gallery and show staff are not responsible for damage, theft, or loss of any vendor's product or property.

I agree to the above requirements and have attached a copy of my license. I assume all responsibility for my products and for safeguarding my booth/food trailer. I hereby release and hold harmless Sandpiper Art Gallery and its agents for any damage, loss or injury resulting from my participation in this event. I certify that I have valid Liability Insurance and am responsible for any damage caused by myself, my products or my booth/food trailer.
